

Your first bid, in **sixty seconds**

There is no onboarding, no demo and nothing to install. This is the entire process.

- 1 Open bidsurvivor.space.**
The board is the landing page. No signup wall.
- 2 Find a free hour.**
Empty tiles say so. Anything marked free has no standing bid.
- 3 Tap it and paste your URL.**
That is the only mandatory field. Your name, logo and description are read off your site.
- 4 Confirm.**
A free hour needs no card at all. A contested one takes payment only if you win the race.
- 5 Watch the ticker.**
If you took an hour off somebody, the board says so across the bottom of every page for a minute.

Worth doing before you bid

- ▶ **Read /stats first.** Decide whether the traffic is worth anything to you before you spend anything, not after.
- ▶ **Pick your hour deliberately.** The stats page shows which hours are actually contested. A quiet hour is cheaper and emptier; a busy one costs more and is seen more.
- ▶ **Check your own homepage.** Whatever your site says in its title and meta description is what we will read, and what will appear on your tile.
- ▶ **Verify your email** if you want the \$10. It is granted once, automatically, on the first request after verification.
- ▶ **Decide how long you want to stay up.** The hour is sixty minutes, but a winning bid also holds a Hall of Survivors place for 24 hours, 7 days or 30 days depending on its size. If the afterlife is the point, bid for the board you want to be on.

If nothing happens, you have spent nothing.

That is the actual pitch. An empty hour costs zero dollars, and the numbers that tell you whether it worked are published on a page you do not have to ask us for.
